CONSTRUCTION TIPS

- Fairy house should be fairly durable to weather elements in the Special Events Field.
- Create a strong base structure to build your house on for easier transport, although make it light enough to carry!
- Be creative! Make a fairy garden or use a fun planting pot as the base for easy transportation.
- We recommend to use all natural materials to build your fairy house or garden.
- Examples of materials can include: dry grasses, leaves, sticks, bark, pebbles, pine cones, stones, acorns, feathers, seaweed, nuts, shells, and much more!
- Decorate your house inside and out! This can include landscape and any indoor furnishings you wish to add.
